The report, which was read at the June Board meeting, proved unusually interesting.

Through the removal of Mrs. Graham from Montreal, the Eastern Association was left without a a Directress, and Mrs. F. B. Smith was appointed to represent us, at this Association held in June and to preside at the meeting.

Three new "life-members" have been added to the list this year, Mrs. Vaux, of Brockville, Mrs. Burgess also of Brockville, and Mrs. Utting, of Olivet Circle, Montreal.
