

LEMON PIE. -Two emons. pound white sugar, four ounces butter, one pint of cream (milk will do), and nine eggs. Grate the lemons and mix the butter and sugar together; beat the eggs well, the whites to a froth. Mix all the ingredients but the lemon all the ingredients but the lemost pince; leave until ready to bake. Bake three-quarters of an hour in a moderate oven.

CHEESE STICKS.—Make a rich pie paste; roll it out very thin, grate over this English cheese, and sprinkle tiny this of cayenne pepper over; fold over the paste and roll out again, and put on more cheese as before; when there is enough, and the paste is folded over and rolled out thin, cut it in strips half an inch in width and two fingers in length.
