

H.J. Heinz Sells Baby Food to Russia with EDC Financing

The Honourable Tom Hockin, Minister for International Trade, announced that the Government of Canada, through EDC (Export Development Corporation), would provide financing of up to US\$15.5 million for the sale of baby food produced by the H.J. Heinz Company of Canada to the Russian Federation. This sale represents the second allocation under the Food Line of Credit to Russia, originally signed in April 1992. It is expected that over 600 person-years of employment in Canada will result from this transaction.
