

PARLIAMANTARY BUSINESS

As Canada's Parliament has been in session for some time, it is necessary to consider the time being.

Since business will chiefly in the classes:

A. Parliamentary:

- (1) Select House of Commons committee on reconstruction and re-employment.
- (2) Select House of Commons committee on social security.
- (3) Special Senate committee on post-war conditions.

B. Advisory:

- (1) Advisory committee on mobilization and rehabilitation.
- (2) Advisory committee on reconstruction.
- (3) Advisory committee on economic policy.
- (4) Advisory committee on health insurance.

In addition, the Canadian section of the Joint Canada-United States economic committee sets in an advisory capacity on several matters, including post-war planning.
