VISIT OF THE BRITISH FOREIGN AND COMMONWEALTH SECRETARY

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today that Sir Geoffrey Howe, the British Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary, will visit Canada, September 27 and 28, 1985. Sir Geoffrey will be accompanied by Lady Howe.

Frequent ministerial level political consultations between Canada and the UK are a continuing demonstration of the depth and substance of our relationship. Sir Geoffrey will visit Ottawa at the invitation of Mr. Clark after attending the regular session of the UNGA. Their meeting will expand upon the on-going consultative process concerning the rapidly evolving international situation.
