WILSON TO MEET SWEDISH MINISTER FOR EUROPEAN AFFAIRS AND FOREIGN TRADE

The Honourable Michael Wilson, Minister of Industry, Science and Technology and Minister for International Trade, will meet today in Ottawa the Minister for European Affairs and Foreign Trade of Sweden, Ulf Dinkelspiel.

The ministers will discuss several issues of mutual interest, including Canada-Sweden bilateral trade and their respective countries' concerns about a successful outcome of the Uruguay Round of multilateral trade negotiations in Geneva.

"Canada enjoys excellent trade relations with Sweden, but there is always room for increased trade and investment between our two countries," Mr. Wilson said.

While in Ottawa, Mr. Dinkelspiel will also be meeting with the President of Investment Canada, Jean McCloskey, and the Governor of the Bank of Canada, John Crow. The Swedish Minister will end his three-day visit to Canada tomorrow in Toronto, where he will have further business meetings and attend a reception of the Swedish-Canadian Chamber of Commerce.
