people here who respond to the needs, the wishes and problems of the people of Canada. We are here to represent the people of Canada. I am here to represent the people of Halifax West. The Prime Minister is here to represent the town of Mount Royal. Perhaps the people in the town of Mount Royal do not have problems, but I can tell hon, members that there are problems in Halifax West, in Amqui, in the Matapedia Valley, in Gaspé and all across Canada. The problem is lack of economic activity and unemployment. That is the problem. We need job-creation programs to solve that problem, and that is why we have introduced this motion. That is why we have to stand up and vote on this motion. That is why we are calling upon hon. members opposite to join with us and to forget about the Prime Minister and the town of Mount Royal. Let them forget about that area of Montreal and its mansions, its houses and imported cars. Let them think about the northern regions of Quebec. Let them think about the Gaspé and why a train has to be stopped in the Matapedia Valley to draw attention to these problems.
