## BY - LAWS.

## BY-LAW No. 519.

A BY-LAW to confirm the appointment of County Auditor made by the Warden pursuant to an Act passed at last Session of the Provincial Legislature.

WHEREAS, at the January session of the present year the council did appoint Mr. George Lewis as County Auditor;

And, whereas, after Mr. Lewis being notified by the Clerk of his appointment, the gentleman, owing to a pressure of business, was unable to accept the appointment;

And, whereas no provisions were made by Statute to meet a case similar to this, by which upon refusal of an Auditor from any cause to act, another appointment could be made;

And whereas the circumstances were made known to the Attorney-General, and an amendment to the Municipal Act was passed at last Session, authorizing the Warden of a county in case of refusal of an Auditor to act, to appoint an Auditor;

And whereas the Warden of this County has, in pursuance of the authority vested in him by the aforesaid in part recited amendment, appointed Mr. Fletcher Swayze, as County Auditor, to fill the vacancy caused by Mr. Lewis refusing to act,

Be it therefore enacted, and is hereby enacted, that the said appointment of Mr. Swayze, as County Auditor, be confirmed and is hereby confirmed.
