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SUPERVISOR. (Women's Wards).

1. She shall attend to the making and mending of the patients' clothing, and have the charge of the sewing room, and the distribution of the labor of the female patients.

2. She shall have the oversight of all the women's wards, and see that the hospital regulations and the directions of the Superintendent are carried out, and give special attention to cases of siekness.

3. She shall have charge of all the bedding and bed linen of the hospital.

4. She shall take an inventory of the clothing of the female patients on their admission.

5. She shall keep an account of all the work done under her direction.

HEAD ATTENDANT. (Men's Wards).

1. He shall see to the cleanliness of the men's wards, visiting and inspecting every part of them from time to time.

2. He shall see that the meals are served punctually, and that the dishes, &c., are safely returned.

3. He shall attend with the storekeeper to the issuing of supplies and clothing.

4. He shall relieve the attendants when occasionally absent, whether on leave or from sickness.

5. He shall oversee the male patients when at work, and attend to the amusements and exercise of those not at work.

6. He shall report any want of repairs, whether in the building, outhouses, or fences.
