HATLEY.

The Rev. A. J. Balfour reports :—

Divine service has been held with little or no interruption every Lord's Day during the past year at St. James' Church, Hatley, St. John's Church, Waterville, and at Massawippi. Services have also been given at St. James' Church and St. John's Church on the chief festivals, and on other occasions. Three Sunday Schools have been maintained during the summer and autumn. For one of these, held at King's Corner, I am indebted to Mrs. Earle. I have given much time and thought to Parochial visiting during the year; I have travelled close upon four thousand miles in the discharge of this duty, frequently spending an evening with a family living at a distance from their Church, and sometimes with a family not belonging to our communion, in order that I might bring home to them, as far as it was in my power, the office and duty of a pastor. I hope, and believe, that I have in this way done some good at least in stimulating an interest in the spiritual welfare of the Mission, and in removing misunderstandings and prejudices as to our doctrines and practices. Reference was made in last year's report to a building then recently purchased for a parsonage. A difficulty shortly afterwards arose with regard to obtaining a clear title, but it is confidently expected that it will very soon be satisfactorily removed, and this without expense on our part.
