Unfavorable weather and financial conditions may be accountable for a less active building program, but the falling off no doubt marks the descending to a process of still better, the advance being \$1,191,-000, or 38 per cent. By the good show ling of eastern cities, the record for the two months for all cities is raised to show an increase, including Calgary's decline of \$1,130,000, or 9 per cent.
