Subsequently M. Whitcher acting for the Commissioner expressed his willingness to continue this arrangement, but wished to reduce the proportion to be remitted. His letter is as follows:

With reference to the issue for the current season of fishery licence for salmon fishing statious at those parts of the Seigniories of Rimouski and Métis where the right of fishery is still vested in the Seigniorial proprietors, this Department is willing to allow the customary percentage of 25 per cent off the rents derived.
