of this rule, he shall, *ipse facto*, cease to be a member of this Society, and in ease the book is not returned within ten days, he shall be liable to pay to the Society, in addition to the fines, the value of the whole set, estimated according to the cost of importation. When the set is replaced, he shall be entitled to the odd volumes.

18. None but members of this Society shall have the use of the Law Library, or students of members who may have received from the Barrister with whom they are studying a written permission to be filed with the Secretary, and every such permission shall only be in force from the time of such filing thereof until three months thereafter.

19. The fee for each student, when any is received by a member of the Society, shall not be less than £100, to be paid on entrance to his office; but members shall be at liberty to take students without fee.

20. No articled clerk shall receive any salary or remuneration for his services from the Barrister with whom he studies.

21. There shall be paid by all members resident or practising in Halifax the sum of $\pounds 2$ annually, in even half-yearly payments on the 1st day of July and the 1st day of January of every year.

22. Members not resident or practising in Halifax shall pay annually the sum of $\pounds 1$.
