LARD IS UP

Scarcity of Hogs Responsible For
crease of Cured a Pound.

Lard has been boosted about a cent in price by the jobbers and is now selling at the following figures: In 141-2c; in tubs 14 3-4c; in pails 15c. Retailers' price is about 18 cents pound.

The higher price of hogs is the reason given by the provision jobbers for increasing price of lard, which is much higher than in many years past.
