New York, Dec. 14—A London cable to The World says: El Radical, a prominent Spanish newspaper, says that extensive German plots to destroy railway lines, bridges and tunnels in the province of Huelva (in southwestern Spain, north of Cadiz, and close to the Portuguese frontier), have just come to light, the scheme being to wreck enterprises connected with or owned by the Allies. It is stated that German money to the extent of \$500,000 is being sent to the district for the purpose of Sabotage. Barcelona is named as the headquarters of the plot, which in its ramifications bears a resemblance to the conspiracies recently unearthed in the United States. The German purpose is said to be to frustrate the export of copper from the famous Rio Tinto mine to the Allied countries. Since the command of the sea passed to the Allies, the Rio Tino mine has been the scene of unusual activity.
