TO IMPOSE FULL WILL OF ALLIES ON GERMANY

The supreme war council will meet at Versailles today to take meacures to impose on Germany the "full will of the Allies," because of the unwillingness of Germany to carry out the full terms of the armistice and of the display of arrogance towards the Entente.

The Society of Nations committee of the peace conference has completed one-third of its task.

Sir Robert Borden has been appointed chief representative of the empire on a commission to define the future boundaries of Greece and Roumania.

The Russian Soviet government has announced that it is willing to consider a cessation of military activities and to acknowledge the financial obligations of Russia to creditors of entente nationality, and to pay interest on Russian obligations by the delivery of raw materials.

Victory Bonds for Princess.

Letters from Lady Borden and others, received by Mrs. Pugsley, wife of the lieutenant-governor, indicate that the wedding gift of the women of Canada for Princess Patricia may take the form of Victory Bonds. Local ladies have expressed their approval and a telegram to this effect has been sent to Lady Borden.






