# COAL COMPANY HOUSES

(Glace Bay Gazette.) The Dominion Coal Company have re-cently completed a census of their houses at the mines, from which, by the courtesy

at the mines, from which, by the courtesy of the management, a Gazette representative has been enabled to glean some interesting particulars. The census covers only the houses directly around the mines and does not include the company's houses in Sydney and at Morien.

The number of single dwellings totals 2,300, in addition to which the company own a large number of boarding houses, hotels, and living shacks. An empty company house is a rare occurrence, so that the number of house-holders is equal to the number of houses, namely 2,300 persons. The wives and families number 8,500 souls, making a total of 10,800 persons. In addition there are some 2,400 men living as boarders with the householders, or in the hotels and boarding shacks. The majority of these men are bachelors, but a fair proportion are men who have families in other parts.
