### ALDERMAN TAKE SHIT

**TO THE SCHEME FOR A ROYAL COMMISSION**

At a lengthy session of the bills and by-laws committee yesterday afternoon it was decided to recommend to the council that no plebiscite be taken on the plan of civic government by a mayor and nine aldermen. A resolution to this effect was adopted. This resolution also embodied the request that the council ask the legislature to appoint a royal commission to arrange a sort of constitution for the city. The members of the bills and by-laws committee are Ald. Willet, chairman; Ald. McGilchrist, McLeod, Vauvart, Scully, Recorder Baxter was present at the meeting.

The bill of the Hydro-Electric Power Co. was also discussed and members of the committee were heard in support of it. For the most part it was approved though the city will probably object to some of the sections regarding the digging up of city streets for placing poles, etc. A bill was also introduced for restricting traffic by heavy teams in German street.
