### CHICAGO CRIMES DECREASE

Major crimes, including murder, burglary and robbery, have substantially decreased in Chicago in the last four years and there has been a great decrease in the number of automobile thefts, according to the fourth annual report of Henry Barrett Chamberlain, director of the Chicago crime commission, just made public. Mr. Chamberlain noted, however, that the number of murders decreased 51 per cent in 1920, a year when there were 14 hangings, and the number increased in 1922 when there was but one hanging.
