It is advised that, after having been committed to detention by District Court-Martial, by authority H.Q. 405-E-2380 Admin.3(a)1, dated 16th March, 1944, the marginally-noted soldier was transferred to Montreal, to undergo trial on a civil offence.

2. By M. 1-E853 A(DIS), dated 28th March, 1944, the District Officer Commanding, M.D.NO.4, advised:

"....that the marginally-noted soldier was sentenced to two years in the St. Vincent de Paul Penitentiary, for a civil charge of robbery."

This soldier has not been returned to detention and it is understood that he is undergoing sentence for the civil offence, as aforesaid.
