Referring to official letter of
the 25th ult. I have to inform you
that I have just ascertained that
the check for \$822⁰⁰ therein referred
to was through an accident not
enclosed ^{in this letter} ~~therewith~~. The amount was
the balance then available of the grant for
the current year of amount of
the expenses connected with the
removal of the Sioux to their
Reserve. Since the date of that
letter accounts have been
received from the acting
superintendent for expenses
incurred in connection
with the Sioux amounting
in all to \$66²², leaving
a balance available at
present of \$755⁵⁵. This amount
has accordingly been placed
to your credit today by tele-
graph, as you have been
notified by a telegram
of even date with this of
