Representative Tear was then admitted and instructed in the Grand Lodge rank.

Grand Prelate Peace, of No. 3, from the Special Committee on Distribution of the subjects in the Reports of the Grand Chancellor, Grand Keeper of Records and Seal, and Grand Master of Exchequer, presented the following Report which was adopted:

Your Special Committee on Distribution to whom was referred the Reports of the Grand Lodge Officers, would report and recommend,

- 1. That so much of the Report of the Grand Chancellor as refers to "Visitation of Lodges," "District Deputy Grand Chancellors," "Dispensations Granted," "Condition of Lodges," and "Reports of D.D.G.C.'s," be referred to the Committee on State of the Order.
- 2. That so much of the Report as refers to "Rulings and Decisions," be referred to the Committee on Law and Suspension.
- ( 3. That that portion of the Report relative to the death of the S. K. of R. and S., be referred to a Special Committee.

Your Committee make the following recommendation on the Report of the G. K. of R. & S. :

- That so much of the Report as refers to "Condition of the Order,"
  "Membership of Subordinate Lodges," "Finances of Subordinate Lodges,"
  and "Numerical and Financial Statements," be referred to the Committee
  on State of the Order.
- 2. That so much of the Report as refers to "Semi-Annual Reports," be referred to Committee on Returns and Credentials.
- 3. That that portion of the Report under "Obituary," be referred to the same Special Committee as recommended above on the Grand Chancellor's Report.
- 4. That so much of the Report under the headings "Financial," "Finances of the Grand Lodge," "Statement of all accounts in the Lodges," "Details of Profit and Loss Account," and "Detailed Financial Statement." be referred to the Committee on Finance.

Your Committee further recommend that the Report of the G. M. of E. be referred to the Committee on Finance.
