A large part of the Island has become excited over the comparatively new industry of conducting black fox ranches. Big money is being made out of it, according to reports, and plenty more is predicted. The skin of the black fox demands a high price. Royalty abroad demands it for the skin which will hold gold tippings as none other will. Up to the present the ranches of the Island have not tried to enter the market etxensively for furs. They have found that from other places where ranches are being started there is a strong demand for live foxes, and practically all that are raised are sold for breeding purposes. It is expected that in about five years the industry will have reached a stage where the ranches will be able to supply furs extensively and that then there will probably come a drop in price, but not one that will mean any serious loss in profits to the rancher.—Age-Herald.
