49 Vessels Are Tied Up.

Buenos Ayres, Tuesday—Buenos Ayres has been isolated for twenty-five days by the port strike, which prevents the entrance of transatlantic steamships into the harbors. Forty-nine vessels, most of them laden with general cargoes for this city, were anchored in the roads today. It is feared that they will all proceed to Montevideo to unload.

These vessels aione could transport a sixteenth part of the exportable crops, while an eighth part of the crops could have been moved if this number were added to the cargo carriers which have been diverted from this trade during the month because of the strike.

The loss to the strikers and ship owners alone is estimated by the newapapers at more than 10,000,000 peeos. The loss to the country it is impossible to estimate. The loss in customs has been 500,000 peeos daffly.
