Grand Manan, Dec. 12.—The Grand Manan fisheries for the season of 1320 have been far from remunerative for the operators. This is not on account of any lack of fish, as the catch of all kinds of fish has been abundant. The fish business, however, was the very first to feel the slump now being experienced by so many industries. The cost of all supplies for the operation of the fisheries has been at the very highest pich, salt, gasoline, lines, rope, etc., all being at an extreme price, while the moderate prices at which the market opened for fish were not maintained during the season. The line fisheries were abandoned early in the season because of the condition of the markets for fish.

It will be seen, therefore, that the lot of the fishermen is not a very happy one this season.
