French Debt Doubled
Since The War

Largely Because Germany Failed to Pay, Says Report.

Paris, Dec. 28.—France's debts, including exterior obligations, have attained the colossal figure of \$70 billion, despite her great fiscal effort, says General Cheron in his report on the budget which was distributed today. The total debt of France at the end of 1916 was \$10 billion, but by the end of 1918 but the total has now reached the enormous sum of \$70 billion, he said. "The principal reason," he stated, "is that Germany failed to pay the reparations she owes because of the constant exchange conditions."
