

Constitution, By-Laws and Order of Business

WOMAN'S \* CHRISTIAN \* TEMPERANCE \* UNION

—\*(LOCAL.)\*

ARTICLE I.—NAME.

This Association shall be known as the WOMAN'S CHRISTIAN TEMPERANCE UNION OF ——— AUXILIARY TO THE W. C. T. U. OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA.

ARTICLE II.—OBJECTS.

The objects of the Union shall be, to meet together for prayer and conference, to educate public sentiment up to the standard of total abstinence, train the young, save the inebriate, and secure the legal prohibition and complete banishment of the liquor traffic.

ARTICLE III.—MEMBERSHIP.

Any woman may become a member of the Association by signing the pledge and constitution, and by the payment of ——— per year into the treasury.

Gentlemen may become honorary members by signing the pledge and by the payment of the regular fee. Honorary members are entitled to all the privileges of members, except the vote and holding office.

ARTICLE IV.—OFFICERS.

The officers of this Association shall be a President, 1st Vice-President, and a Vice-President from each church, when practicable, a Corresponding Secretary, Recording Secretary, Treasurer and Auditor.

The officers (excepting the Auditor), with the Superintendent of departments, shall constitute the Executive Committee.
