

MEMBERSHIP AND INSURANCE.

We have now in good standing fifteen hundred and sixty (1560) members. The average insurance is \$2,182.70, and the total insurance \$3,405,000. The average assessment is \$1.60.

We have carefully examined the reports of many similar associations—all of them well managed—and our own Society appears to have furnished safe, prompt, and reliable insurance at less cost than any other.

The Relief Society has been helpful to the Order. Organizers find it easy to secure charter members when they present the advantages of the insurance feature. More than one hundred and fifty members of the National Division, including the Most Worthy Patriarch and six Past Most Worthy Patriarchs, are members of the Relief Society. The M. W. Associate, M. W. Treasurer, and M. W. Chaplain are also members.

All Sons of Temperance in good health, who are over eighteen and under sixty years of age, are invited to join us.

We offer you an insurance of from \$500 to \$3,500, on a total abstinence basis. Only Sons of Temperance are eligible. Be not unequally yoked with drinking men.

Our admission fee is small. We have no quarterly or annual dues. Our assessments are equitably graded, and are not increased with advancing years. We pay death claims promptly. We are growing slowly, but steadily, having made a net gain every year since our organization.

ASSESSMENTS.

An assessment is collected for each death occurring in the Society, except when there is a sufficient amount in the treasury to pay the claim. The rate of assessment at all ages, and for the different amounts of insurance, is given in the table below, as follows:
