An Act to exempt universal legatees from the obligation to demand delivery (*delivrance*) of legacies in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS the obligation imposed by the Law of Lower Canada, Preamble. on universal legatees to demand delivery (*délivrance*) of the legacy from the heirs-at-law, constitutes an anomaly, and is a mere useless formality; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

5 I. Hereafter no delivery (*délivrance*) of any legacy à titre universel shall Delivery need be necessary, and the legatee shall be seized of the same of full right; not be deany law, usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. This Act shall apply to Lower Canada only.
