An Act to declare that Parishes and Townships, canonically erected, shall enjoy the benefits and advantages of the Lower Canada Municipal Act of 1860.

WHEREAS the crection, division, or sub-division of Parishes in Preamble. Lower Canada is effected by canonical decree, and whereas the unrestricted exercise of this right is one of the foundations of our religous and social Institutions in Lower Canada, and whereas the Lower 5 Canada Municipal Act of 1860, undermines this principle at its base,

Therefore Her Majesty enacts as follows :

I. Whenever a parish, or part of a parish, is canonically erected within the limits of a Seignory or Township, such parish, or part of a parish, to extend to shall enjoy all the rights and privileges of the Lower Canada Municipal certain par-

10 Act of 1860, and also of any other Municipal Act, hereafter to be passed.

II. Any parish, or part of a parish, so canonically crected, shall retain the name which shall have been given to it by the Canonical Decree.

15 III. Any part of a parish or township, which is annexed to another In case of anparish, shall take the canonical name, and shall enjoy all the rights and privileges of the parish, for the advantage of which such annexation another. has been effected.

IV. The word "Parish" in the Municipal Act before cited, shall sig-20 nify, and shall be deemed always to have signified any territory erected "Parish." either canonically or civilly.

V. This Act applies to Lower Canada only.
