I find that no report has been received at this department of the steps which were taken in consequence of Mr. Spring Rice's despatch, and I have to request that your Lordship will supply this omission by furnishing me, at your earliest convenience, with full information on the subject, including copies of any correspondence which has passed between the Governor of Lower Canada and Mr. Felton. I need hardly observe, that if any circumstance should have hitherto postponed the execution of Mr. Spring Rice's instructions in this matter, your Lordship will understand that they are still in force, and will proceed to give them immediate effect. In this case you will report to me without delay the measures which you will have taken and their result.
