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8th - The same Answer as No 2. —

9th - It was customary when I had the direction of Indian Affairs to issue Provisions & Presents from the Government stores on such occasions. —

10th - The same Answer Applies equally to this Observation.

11th - The Mill ought to support itself and is Capable of doing so, as well as of yielding a handsome ~~profit~~ Revenue. —

12th - The Law Officers of the Crown have been repeatedly directed to attend to such matters and have always done so when Applied to. —

13th - The Revenue Arising from the Property now belonging to the Indians of Saint Louis is sufficient to meet these expenses which are for the most part of a trifling nature. —

14th - This Observation is decidedly incorrect, as may be seen by a reference to the foregoing Answers & to the Observation No. 1. which states, that the Missionary is allowed 50 Guineas by the Government. —

15th - The Medical Officers of the Army Attached to the Garrison of Montreal have received repeated orders from Head Quarters to afford Medical Aid, and have always
