



Sir,-

With reference to letter addressed to you on the 5th instant, I beg to enclose an account for drugs supplied to the Brandon School by J. W. Fleming as the prices charged are not in accordance with the list prices and would ask you to report if one of the authorized lists was supplied to Mr. Fleming and was he informed that only those prices would be allowed? If so this account should be returned to him with a request that the prices be reduced. If he will not supply drugs at the authorized list prices the Department cannot approve of purchases being made from him, and he should be so informed.
