Sir—


Referring to your letter and enclosure of the 2nd January, last, No. 465 B.5., I beg to inform you that the sum of \$600 has been voted and is now available for the purpose of providing water supply for the Indians of Skidegate Village.

It is understood that this sum is to be expended in the purchase of pipes and other material and freight thereon and that the Indians will lay the pipes and do all the work in connection therewith.

Kindly instruct the Agent to forward for the information of the Department a report giving the diameter of the pipe, its total length, depth in the ground etc etc., accompanied by a sketch showing its approximate location.

The work may be immediately proceeded with. The usual vouchers <sup>should be</sup> forwarded for all expenditures.
