SUB - COUNCILS

COMPOSITION AND RULES

- (a) Within and under the control of the International Court. shall be formed various sub-councils.
- (b) Each sub-council shall deal with a particular section only, except in cases where it is allowed, by express permission of the International Court only, to take part in other sub-councils deliberations. This shall only be permissible in order to settle interlocking problems.
- (c) No sub-council shall deal directly with any other sub-council, but shall make all reports and decisions directly to the full assembly of the International Court.
- (d) Information required by any sub-council for its work shall be obtainable from the International Court's Bureau of Information and Library.

 (See Bureau of Information and Library.)
- (e) The members of a sub-council shall be elected from the members of the International Court.
- (f) No one party or nation shall have a majority of members on any sub-council.
- (g) Members of sub-councils shall be elected for a period not exceeding two (2) years.
- (h) Members of sub-councils shall not be re-elected to the same sub-council until the expiration of a full term of two (2) years.
