 BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER:
- Q-696 Where is your billet from the main gate?
- A-696 Right ther (indicating).
 BY THE PRESIDENT:
- 0-697 That is Park street?
- A-697 Barber street, sir.
- Q-698 That is Highway No. 68, is it?
- A-698 Yes, sir.

 BY THE DEFENDING OFFICER:
- Q-699 Do you remember October 31st?
- A-699 Yes, sir.
- Q-700 Were you expecting Brandon over to see you that night?
- A-700 Yes, sir; he was supposed to come up that night.

- A-701 We were to have a game of cards.

- A-704 Brandon was to bring them up.
