ABSENTEEING HIMSELF WITHOUT LEAVE

IN that he

At Petawawa Military Camp, Petawawa, Ontario, on the
28th day of September, 1942 absented himself without
leave from Camp Headquarters Details, Petawawa Military
Camp, Petawawa, Ontario from 0600 hours on the said 28th
day of September, 1942 until he re-enlisted in the
Canadian Army (Active) at No 2 District Depot, C.A.,
Toronto, Ontario at 0001 hours on the 8th day of
February, 1943 under the name of Arthur Joseph Harvey.

SECOND CHARGE
SECTION 13 (1)(a)
ARMY ACT

FRAUDULENT ENLISTMENT

IN that he

At Toronto, Ontario on the 8th day of February, 1943
when belonging to Camp Headquarters Details, Petawawa
Military Camp, Petawawa, Ontario without having fulfilled
the conditions enabling him to enlist, re-enlisted into
No 2 District Depot, C.A., Infantry (R) R Wing for
General Service

THIRD CHARGE
SECTION 12 (1)(a)

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE
DESERTING HIS MAJESTY'S SERVICE

IN that he

At No 20 Canadian Infantry (Basic) Training Centre, C.A.,
Brantford, Ontario on the 9th day of October, 1944
absented himself without leave from No 20 Canadian Infantry
(Basic) Training Centre, C.A., Brantford, Ontario from
1200 hours on the said 9th day of October, 1944 until he
was apprehended by the Military Authorities at Montreal,
Quebec at 1300 hours on the 6th day of November, 1944
dressed in Military Uniform, the cost of apprehension
and return to his Corps being \$22.46.

FOURTH CHARGE
SECTION 12(1)(a)
ARMY ACT

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE
DESERTING HIS MAJESTY'S SERVICE

IN that he

At Toronto, Ontario on the 8th day of November, 1944
absented himself without leave from No 20 Canadian
Infantry (Basic) Training Centre, C.A., Brantford,
Ontario from 2200 hours on the said 8th day of
November, when in arrest, until he was apprehended
by Military Authorities at Ottawa, Ontario at 0130
hours on the 29th day of January, 1945, dressed in
Military Uniform, the cost of apprehension and
return to his Corps being \$18.12.
