SECOND WITNESS WIT 80 CPl Tousignant AT having been duly sworn states:

I am M17180 Cpl Tousignant AT of #7 Provost Coy, I was on duty in the 0/H of #7 Provost Det on the night of 7 Nov 44. I recognize Pte Jones, he along brought in they also brought in by Pte McDonald. Then they were account in the party of Ladies' clothing and a bottle brought in they also brought in a quantity of Ladies' clothing and a bottle of liquor. I don't remember whether or not I checked the things that were brought in. I turned the whole thing over to the S.I.S. to a sgt. I don't brought in, Pte McDonald told me that he had taken the bundle from these soldiers. I can't recall whether or not he mentioned who he had actue go out and fight with them, during these arguements I saw 'te Jones take a McDonald because he ducked when he waw the bottle coming his way. I am sure it was 'te Jones who threw the bottle because he was very close to me.

CROSS EXAMINATION BY THE DEFENCE Q Did you make a list of the articles that were handed to you by McDonald?

- Q Can you tell the court now what the articles were? A No not all of them, I know it consisted of Ladies' clothing and a
- Q Did you take down any other particulars? A Yes I took down the regimental particulars of the three soldiers.
- Q Was there a list with the articles when they wereturned over to the SIS A I don't remember sir.
- Q Is it part of the O/cpl's duty to list articles that are brought in and
- suspected of being stolen?
 A No sir, it is only his duty to list them when the case is going to be handled by the members of the Company.
- C Did Pte Jones start the fight in the O/R? A No sire
- Q Did the fight start close to your desk? A Owing to the size of the room, the fight would have started about ten feet
- Q where were you when the fight started? A I was sitting at my desk.
- Q Where was Pte Jones and Pte McDonald? Jones was at my left and McDonald at my right, both standing at the ends
- Q Did anyone grab Pte Jones? A Yes sir, Pte McDonald grabbed him.
- Q Is that how McDonald got ink on his uniform?
- Q Was "te Jones drunk? A I would say he was under the influence of liquor.
- R.P. 83 (b) has been complied with.
