prosecution?

Fourth Witness. Capt A.J. West, on the strength of No 1 C.A.R.U., having been duly sworn states:

> am Capt A.J. West, Administration Officer of "P" Training Wing, No 1 C.A.R.U. I produce a certified true copy of an extract from No 1 C.A.R.U. Part I Orders, No 69, dated 9 Mar 44, which forbids gambling (which said extract is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "C") I have checked records and have ascertained that E-6015 Bdr Lachance, R., was on strength of "B" Bty., No 1 C.A.P.U., on 9 Mar 44.

The above record is read to the witness.

The accused declines to cross-examine this witness.

The Accused was cautioned as follows:

Do you wish to make any statement or to give evidence on Oath? You are notobliged to say anything, or to give evidence unless you wish to do so, but whatever you say or any evidence you give, will be taken down in writing, and may be given in evidence.

The Accused declines to make a statement and reserves his defence.

I certify that the foregoing Summary of Evidence, consisting of two pages and three exhbits, was taken down by me in the presence and hearing of the Accused, and that Rules of Procedure 4 (c)(d)(e)(f) have been complied with.
