Witness or the Prosecution (Continued)

Lieut Stephen asked him not to interfere. The Opl insisted and tried to get free again. He was taken around the other side of the police box. Approx 10 minutes later the Provost truck and escorts arrived and the Opl and the two Tprs were taken to the Police Station in Staines where I assisted the escort.

Gross-examined by the accused.

What do you mean when you say I tried to get away? Myself and L/Cpl Lapointe had you by the arm and were accosting you along with us. You did not want to go, was the opinion I had as a fight was in progress with the Cpl and other Tor. Bushing Us. During the struggle 9.1 A.1 was the opinion I had as a Fight was in progress with the Cpl and other Tpr., behind us. During the struggle we had with Ragen he ended up on the ground. He requested us to take it easy and had lost his cap and I had lost mine also. Then we let Tpr Hagen up, gave him his hat and proceeded on our way to the police phone box.

What were Lt Stephen's exact words?
Lt Stephen said "You will take these men away and have them placed under arrest" he repeated, "take these men away" about 3 times. A.2
