
Dear Sir:

Further to the survey being carried out by your Company I attach herewith a plan submitted to us by the B.C. Electric showing the 26.72 acre portion presently under consideration for sale to that Company.

The B.C. Electric Company have made an outright offer to us for the purchase of the land leaving title to the timber in the Squamish Indian Band. You will readily understand that in order to assess the offer of the company we must have as soon as possible a report on the variable timber on this particular portion of 26.72 acres, and in particular the type of timber and possible sale value thereof.

I do not know when we may expect your full report on these reserves, but it would be very much appreciate if you would particularize this 26.72 acre as shown on the attached plan and give us a fairly close idea of what timber types and values may be expected from the same. Your early dealing with this matter will be very much appreciated.
