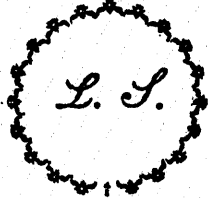

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS an Act was passed in the last Session of the General Assembly of this Province, intituled "An Act for the encouragement of the Trade of this Province in Plaster of Paris, otherwise called Gypsum," with a clause enacting that the said Act should not be in force until His Majesty's Royal approbation should be thereunto had and declared: And whereas His Majesty's Royal approbation has been thereunto had and declared: And whereas similar and corresponding provisions as near as may be in all material respects, have been enacted by an Act of the General Assembly of the Province of Nova-Scotia passed for that purpose: I do therefore, by and with the advice and consent of His Majesty's Council, publish this Proclamation, hereby declaring the said Act to be in force, whereof all Persons whom it may concern will take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.
