referred to a Committee of five Members; whereof three shall form a Quorum, and that the said Committee do report with all possible diligence.

Mr. Papineau moved in amendment to the same, seconded by Mr. Duniere, that after the last word thereof the sollowing be added " And " that all Members of this House who come to the Committee shall have " voices."

Which, upon the question, was agreed unto by the House.
And the main question, as amended, being put, it was also agreed to unanimously by the House.

ORDERED, that the Bill "To regulate the rights and forms of last wills and testaments," be referred to a Committee of five Members, whereof three shall form a Quorum, that the said Committee do report with all possible diligence, and that all Members of this House who come to the Committee shall have voices.

ORDERED, that Messieurs Dumas, Papineau, Planté, Grant and Berthetot, do compose the said Committee.

And then, on motion of Mr. Planté, seconded by Mr. Berthelot, The House adjourned till Friday next.

## Friday, 25th April, 1800.

A Bill to amend an Ordinance passed in the 25th year of His pretent Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Ordinance to regulate the proceedings in the Courts of Civil Judicature and to establish Trials by Juries in actions of a Commercial nature and personal wrongs to be compensated in damages," was read for the second time.
