

CHAPTER 1,*

An Act to provide for the examination of witnesses on Oath by Committees of the Senate and House of Commons, in certain cases.

[Assented to 3rd May, 1873.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Preamble. Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. Whenever any witness or witnesses is or are to be examined Examination by any Committee of the Senate or House of Commons, and the on oath. Senate or House of Commons shall have resolved that it is desirable that such witness or witnesses shall be examined upon path, such witness or witnesses shall be examined upon oath, or affirmation, where affirmation is allowed by law.
- 2. Such oath or affirmation shall be administered by the How administered have the How administered as aforesaid.
- 3. Any witness giving false evidence upon any such examina-Perjury. tion, shall be subject and liable to all the pains and penalties of perjury, as fixed by the criminal law.
- 4. The oath or affirmation aforesaid shall be in the following Form of eath. form: "The evidence you shall give on this examination shall be the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth. So help you God."
