FIFTEENTH YEAR STRONGER THAN EVER. Mowat for the Seventh Time Elected.

HIS MAJORITY HAS BEEN INCREASED. Hon. W. Marty Defeated in Kingston.

For the seventh successive time Mowat yesterday swept the province. He goes back to power with a clear majority of 7 over the whole Opposition, and as 11 of the Patrons elected are Liberals his strength is greater than at dissolution.

Never before have there been candidates of so many different complexions in the field, and surprises were naturally expected, but they are not so great as had been anticipated. The Liberals lost 8 seats to the Conservatives and the Conservatives lost eight seats to the Liberals, so that honors are easy on that score.

Among the Conservatives who have met defeat are Mr. James Clancy of Kent and Mr. G. W. Monk of Carleton, the Conservative whip. Of the 48 Patron candidates in the field 14 were elected.
