Volkyrie and Defender's Second Race Over a Ten Mile Long Triangular Course.

New York, Sept. 9.—The Defender and the Volkyrie lay at anchor this morning about a half-mile apart, off Bay Bridge. They were continually surrounded by a fleet of boats containing curious spectators.

The sailors on the Defender were engaged in scrubbing down her free-board, scrubbing her deck and making the thousands of preparations necessary before a race. H. Mattison, Kenney went on board the Volkyrie at 10:30 o'clock. He said: "The Volkyrie will be all ready for tomorrow's contest. We all hope to do better than on Saturday. I have more to do about Saturday's race. It is now a matter of history."

The Volkyrie's crew were as busy all the morning as the Defender's, and doing practically the same work. Weather Officer Dunn has promised fair weather for tomorrow, the second day of the international yacht series. "The present indications for tomorrow," he said, "are that we shall have fair weather and light breeze, but that the breeze will probably vary from 5 to 10 miles. The chances are that the weather will remain good during the entire period of the race. There is no storm to be feared, and no reason to expect one."
