- 3. In suits for subscriptions, the suit may be instituted in the place where the paper is published, no matter where the subscriber may reside.
- 4. The courts have decided that refusing newspapers or periodicals from a post office.or removing and leaving them uncalled for while unpaid, is prima facie evidence of intentional trand.
