1. Any person who takes a paper regularly from a post office, whether in his name or another's, or whether he has subscribed or not, is responsible for payment.
2. If a person orders a paper discontinued he must pay up all arrears or the publisher may continue to send it until payment is made and then collect the whole amount whether the paper is taken from the office or not.
3. In suits for subscriptions, the suit may be instituted in the place where the paper is publinhed, no matter where the subscriber may reside.
4. The courts have decided that refusing newspapers or periodicals from a post office.or removing and leating them uncalled for while unpaid, is prima racie evidence of intentional fraud.
