Curry vinegar is made by adding three counces of curry powder to one quart of vinegar; let it stand in a covered earthen dish or jar near the fire for three days. This gives an excellent flavour to all kinds of sour pickles. Remember, when using it, that a pickles. Remember, when using it, that a little goes a great way.

FLANNEL that has become yellow from being badly washed may be nicely whitened by soaking it two or three hours in a lather made of one-quarter of a pound of curd soap, two tablespoonfuls of powered borax, and two tablespoonfuls of carbonate of ammonia, dissolved in five or six gallons of water.

In making soup, it is better to boil the vegetables separately from the meat and strain both meat and vegetable water, and mince the vegetables before putting them with the so strained liquors. Soups are more wholesome, and far more palatable for hot weather than meats, but a good piece of meat is required to make nourishing soup.

TO MAKE BREAD-PUDDING .- Put the TO MAKE BREAD-PUDDING.—Put the scraps of bread into the oven and toast brown, roll them, while hot, quite fine. To two cups of crumbs, take one quart of milk, three eggs, one cup of sugar, one cup of sugar, one tablespoonful of butter, the same of flour; mix together, then add the juice of one lemon, or any flavouripe desired.

CRACKED wheat makes a very nice dish if baked with plenty of water added from time to time as it is needed, to allow the wheat to expand. It should bake slowly for from five to six hours, and it will then be found to be remarkably sweet and wholesome. It is delicious if baked with milk instead of water, but will then need more attention when in the oven to prevent scorching.

POTATO puff with the addition of a little cold meat makes an excellent breakfast dish. To two cups of cold mashed potatoes allow two well beaten eggs, two tablespoonfuls of melted butter, and one cup of sweet milk; beat all together until very light, then add the cold meat, chopped very fine. After mixing thoroughly put it in a shallow pudding dish, and bake for from twenty minutes to half an hour. If preferred, you can bake in well buttered gem-pans.

BANANAS are delicious for tea; slice them—not too thin—scatter powdered sugar over

—not too thin—scatter powdered sugar over them, and before it dissolves squeeze the juice of several oranges over them, or oranges may be cut up and mixed with them, or they may be served with cream and sugar alone. They make an agreeable dessert with whipped cream sweetened and flavoured with vanilla poured over them. A tablespoonful of gela-tine dissolved and stirred into the cream gives a little body to it. Serve with sponge-cake.

A NICE and easily made suct pudding is made of one cup of suct, chopped fine, and with every bit of gristle removed, one cup each of molasses, milk and fruit; raisins and currants mixed, or dried, cherries are better for this purpose; one heaping tablespoonful of soda, dissolved in a little hot water, comof soda, dissolved in a little hot water, com-plete the ingredients called for, with the ex-ception of flour enough to make a stiff batter. Take care to stir the flour in so gradually as to be certain not one lump, if ever so small, is left. Steam in an earthen pudding-dish for three hours; serve with wine sauce, or with common pudding sauce of flour, sugar, butter and water.


