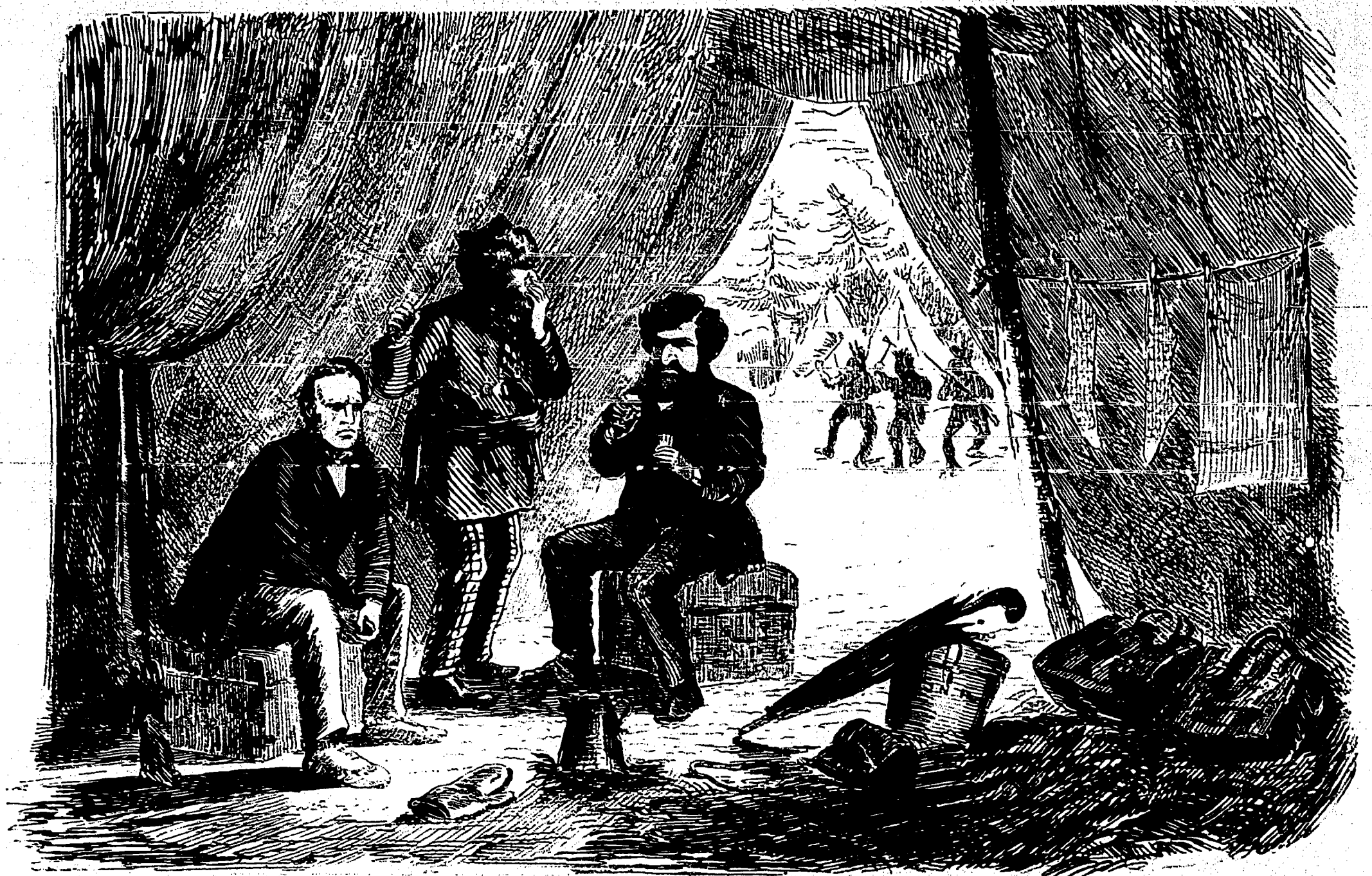


OUR ABSENT FRIENDS.—A SCENE NEAR PEMBINA, (supposed.)
